For 2021, OUP has added 14 new titles, including journals from prestigious societies such as the Royal Society of Chemistry, the Genetics Society of America, and the Royal Pharmaceutical Society.

Has a NC-only CC deal for a package of 14 databases at a steeply discounted price. This package will no longer be offered to new subscribers, but existing subscriptions will be honored.

FEATURED - IGI Global eBooks



Six CC libraries are participating in a cooperative ebook purchase deal, through which we currently share ownership of 24 titles. If other CC libraries make IGI purchases, then their titles can be added to, and their students and faculty can gain access to, the shared title pool. Even if you only purchase a single, inexpensive title.

All journal big deals, including Cambridge, Elsevier, Mary Ann Liebert, Oxford, SAGE, Springer, and Wiley.

EBSCO renewals for subscriptions ending December 31 include:

Premier, Complete, and Ultimate packages; America History and Life; APA PsycINFO; Art & Architecture Source; Associates Programs Source; Child Development & Adolescent Studies; CINAHL Complete; CMMC; Communication Source; Entrepreneurial Studies Source; Environment Complete; ERIC; HAPI; Health Source; Historical Abstracts; Humanities International; Humanities Complete; and Library and Information Science Source. Renewal decisions due to Tim by Thanksgiving.

The APA has not yet provided EBSCO with the 2021 price increase for the renewal due January 1, but we expect to see that soon. We have 2 different CC PsycINFO deals - a stand-alone PsycINFO subscription or, for a slightly higher cost, a "Pick 4" deal that gives you PsycINFO plus your choice of 4 databases from among:

NEWS AND UPDATES

PrepSTEP is moving to NC LIVE, effective 1/1/21, so NC libraries will not need to renew their institutional subscriptions.

SimplyAnalytics and CQ Magazine are both leaving NC LIVE at the end of the year. For schools wishing to maintain their access, we have CC offers for both products.

In 2019, The UC System ended their big deal with Elsevier and decided not to subscribe to any individual Elsevier journals at all. UC recently announced that they would restart their negotiations, probably because circumstances make this an especially favorable time to negotiate, and because they want to reinstate real-time access to Elsevier's numerous prestigious, high impact journals.
