The Carolina Consortium Advisory Group met during Open Access Week and approved the following statement on Open Access-

The Carolina Consortium strongly supports Open Access because it ensures the <u>broadest possible</u> <u>dissemination</u> of high quality information. We are currently experimenting with several different OA models and would welcome the opportunity to build OA into more of our consortium deals. Joseph Thomas (East Carolina University) is coordinating and leading many of the CC's OA initiatives, which currently include:

Two uncapped Read and Publish deals -Cambridge and Karger

One Read and Publish deal with a shared voucher pool - Wiley (coming soon!)

One Subscribe to Open deal - Annual Reviews

One limited voucher deal - IGI Global

Two flat APC Discount deals - Oxford and SAGE
