**CC NEWS****Karger Big Deal**

Because Karger insisted on extremely large % increases for 2023, the CC Karger deal will be terminated at the end of 2022. Schools are welcome to negotiate directly with Karger.

**FEATURED - BRILL Journals**

Founded in 1683, Brill is headquartered in the Netherlands and has offices in Germany, Austria, the United States, and Asia. Brill publications focus on the humanities, social sciences, international law, and selected areas in the sciences.

The CC Brill journal deal is one of our least expensive big deals in terms of both total price tag and very low cost per title. There are 345 titles in the 2023 package, including:

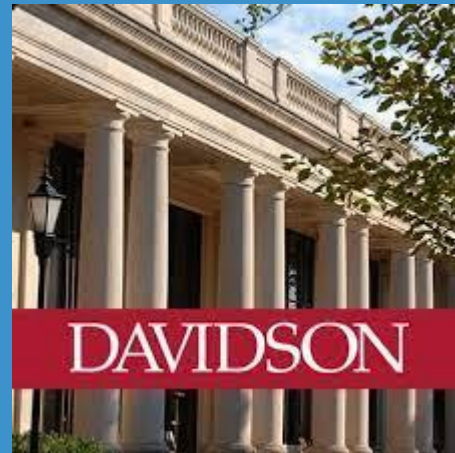
## CC Library Spotlight-

## Upcoming Renewals and Expirations

The following EBSCO database renewals expire December 31<sup>st</sup>. Tim will request renew/cancel/join decisions from CC subscribers in November.

America: History and Life, APA PsycINFO, Art & Architecture Source, CINAHL Complete, CMMC, Communication Source, HaPI, Historical Abstracts, Humanities International Complete, Humanities Source, Library and Information Science Source, and the Academic Package that includes 13 databases.

*2023 updates on the CC journal and EBS deals that operate on a calendar year renewal cycle:*

**Annual Reviews** - 51 journals, primarily in the sciences

Moving from partial Subscribe to Open, to Full.

2023 Renewal pricing info has been shared with the CC.

**Brill** - nearly 250 journals, mostly humanities and social sciences

2023 Renewal pricing info has been shared with the CC.

**Cambridge University Press** - Includes 400+ active and 100+ inactive titles.

Uncapped read and publish deal.

2023 is year 3 of our three year deal. Prices and details have been distributed.

If you are in this deal and do not plan to renew for 2023, you need to contact Tim and the publisher ASAP.

**Duke University Press** - Standard collection has 45 journals and Expanded has 57

2023 prices and details have been distributed

**Elsevier** - Nearly 1500 active journals.

2023 is year 2 of our three year deal. You should have already received any relevant title transfer information.

If you are in this deal and do not plan to renew for 2023, you need to contact Tim and the publisher ASAP.

**IGI Global** - 110+ journals, mostly in education, library science, and IT

Participation may entitle you to receive APC vouchers.

2023 Pricing and other details have been distributed.

**Karger** - 80+ journal, nearly all medical

Because of excessive price increases for 2023, this R&P will be discontinued as a CC deal at the end of 2022. If you are interested in continuing or joining a deal with Karger, you should work directly with the company.

**Mary Ann Liebert** - 65 peer reviewed titles, mostly in the health and life sciences

2023 Pricing and other details have been distributed.

**Oxford journals** - About 375 titles

2023 will be the first year of a new CC three year deal. Pricing and other details have been distributed.

**Oxford Ebook EBS** - access to 17,000 OUP monographs, with annual purchase of about 1300.

In 2023, NC CC schools can opt to join a shared ebook deal.

**SAGE Premier** - Nearly 1000 journals, with an emphasis on the social sciences.

2023 will be the first year of a new three year deal that is currently in negotiation. Pricing is not yet available.

**Springer** - Custom package of about 1500, or expanded package of about 2300 journals.

2023 is year 3 of our three year CC deal. Pricing and other details have been distributed.

If you are in this deal and do not plan to renew for 2023, you need to contact Tim and the publisher ASAP.

**Wiley** - about 1500 journals

Read and publish deal, with over 700 shared APC vouchers.

2023 is year 2 of a three year deal. Pricing and other details have been distributed.

If you are in this deal and do not plan to renew for 2023, you need to contact Tim and the publisher ASAP.
