



BORROWING PRINT BOOKS FROM JACKSON LIBRARY/HSML/ILL

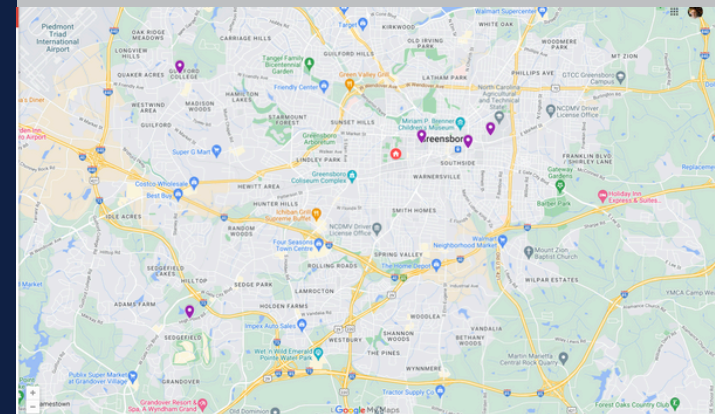
The majority of the print collection from Jackson will be unavailable from January 2025-summer 2026. Books that are returned during this time will be available for checkout, as will books in our on-campus remote storage facility. Both can be requested through the library catalog. UNCG students, faculty, and staff can request print items through Interlibrary Loan throughout the renovation. Book borrowing from the Harold Schiffman Music Library will stay the same.

BORROWING FROM OTHER ACADEMIC LIBRARIES

UNCG students, faculty, and staff can borrow print books directly at other colleges and universities in the Piedmont Triad and any school in the UNC System. Each institution has different rules about borrowing, so please check with each school before you visit. You will need your Spartan Card to register to borrow.
